Background

The Athletic Component is one of the four Components of the Royal Military College of Canada. The Athletics Program is designed to provide opportunities for all officer-cadets to participate in physical activities and sports that are mentally demanding in order to develop their overall physical capabilities, self-confidence and leadership.

Contact sports develop courage and aggressiveness; other team sports develop self-sacrifice and esprit de corps; individual sports expand an individual's confidence, poise and self-reliance; all sports develop self-discipline and the ability to react quickly and accurately under pressure while retaining control and presence of mind. The Athletics Program is therefore extremely important in the training of officer-cadets for effective service as officers in the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF).

Objective

The Royal Military College of Canada (RMC) Women's Soccer Program is seeking highly-motivated and organized individual to serve as Assistant Coach.

Under the guidance of the RMC Women's Soccer Head Coach, the assistant coach is responsible for the continuous development of the varsity teams through coaching and athlete progression.

Tasks:

- 1. The Contractor must attend team practices at least four times per week or as otherwise mutually agreed upon.
- 2. The Contractor will attend team competitions throughout the duration of the contract.
- 3. The Contractor must instruct and train the athletes in practice and games.
- 4. The Contractor must follow and respect the guidelines and procedures as indicated in the Varsity Handbook. The Handbook will be made available to the Contractor electronically.
- 5. Upon completion of the contract, the Contractor must provide a written after action report, complete with recommendations for future arrangements for assistant coaching services of the RMC varsity team.

Qualifications:

- ✓ Current NCCP Level 1 coaching certification preferred
- ✓ Ontario Soccer 'C' License or equivalency through playing/coaching experience
- ✓ Experience with military sports/athletes is an asset
- ✓ Minimum 2 years coaching experience at the post-secondary level preferred

Language requirement:

English essential, bilingualism (French / English) a strong asset.

15 August 2019 to 18 November 2019 (unless otherwise agreed upon)

The Contract stipend will be commensurate with the Contractor's experience and qualifications (Travel Expenses will be covered, according to the number of days allotted for travel based on the team schedule, and will follow current Treasury Board Guidelines).
